

Home Learning Instructions

Subject: Art year 8	Week commencing: 12/10/2020
Objectives: To take your colour wheel knowledge forward into your designs. To create art work with strong geometry links.	
Learning activities (in order to be completed): Firstly, watch the video link on Folk Art by Kristin Farr. She is a folk artist inspired by folk art , the colour wheel and magic. Research Kristin Farr work and choose 2 of your favourite designs. You are going to replicate 2 of her designs using coloured pencils or felt pens, whichever you feel will look best. Have a look at the 'Art images' document, there are 2 of her designs on there that would be a good starting point for this weeks task. Print off the 'Art template' and work on that. I have already divided up one of the wheels into 16 segments, if you want your work to be extra detailed you can divide it further in 32. The second wheel you must divide up for yourself using the number to number guide around the edge. Think about colour combinations when creating your geometric patterns, you don't have to replicate her work completely. Remember the colour groups you have learned about in the past: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Harmonious• Complimentary• Monochromatic• Warm/Cold
