Objectives: To develop necessary skills for practical application	
<p>Learning activities (in order to be completed):</p> <p>As a way to improve aspects of DT. Please complete the following.</p> <p>Draw a square that is 10 cm x 10 cm, now draw a circle that measure 4 cm across, draw a triangle that is symmetrical.</p> <p>Now shade two of the shapes using a pencil crayon. This must be neat and have no white spaces.</p> <p>Next cut out your shapes leaving the pencil line showing, this will test your scissor accuracy.</p> <p>Stick the shapes on a piece of card arranging them neatly.</p> <p>Write a title with a ruler underline <u>DT tasks</u></p> <p>This may seem simple, so let's now draw 5 lines one wiggly one straight and one with wavy curves. Now cut along the lines. How did you do?</p> <p>Practice your colouring and cutting out over the next week.</p> <p>EXT try making something using simple origami</p>
