

Home Learning Instructions

Subject: Art year 8	Week commencing: 19/10/2020
Objectives: To create Art with strong links to geometry. To further your knowledge of the colour wheel.	
Learning activities (in order to be completed): Print off another 'Art template' to work on. Alternatively, you can draw your own concentric circles with a compass – this way allows you more freedom and means you can work on a larger scale. You are going to create a further 2 designs inspired by the folk artist Kristin Farr. One design must be using harmonious colours. One design must use tints and shades of a colour. A tint is the lighter version of a colour (e.g. Light blue) and a shade is the darker version (e.g. Dark blue), for this pencil crayons are easier to work with as you can change the pressure that you are applying with.
